Course Selection

A course selection is subject to prior approval by relevant Faculty. Applicants are advised to consult their home university programme coordinator before choosing their courses. UNIMAS Global will communicate with partner university and assist in the process where necessary.

Application Dateline

Student Exchange Programme is offered twice annually as detailed below:

Semester	Semester Duration	Nomination & Application Deadlines
SEMESTER 1 (Fall Semester)	September to February	Nomination: 1 June Application Deadline: 30 June
Semester 2 (Spring Semester)	Mac to July	Nomination: 1 December Application Deadline: 31 December

Fees and Charges

Tuition fees for applicants from partner universities are subject to the agreement between both universities as indicated in the MoU or MoA while other expenses (e.g. accommodation, transportation, study materials, cost of living and etc.) are to be borne by the students.

Application Requirements

To participate in the UNIMAS student exchange programme, the applicant must fulfill the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be a full-time student who has completed at least ONE (1) semester or one year of study at home university
2. For students that the English language is not the medium of instruction, the applicant is required to fulfill the minimum language requirement as stated below:
 - a. IELTS score of 5.5, TOEFL iBT 46, Pearson Test of English 43, Cambridge Qualifications and Tests 51 or aligned and equivalent to CEFR Low B2*; or
 - b. Provide evidence of English Proficiency
3. The applicant has evidence of sufficient funds to support himself/herself while studying at UNIMAS
4. Obtain a support letter from the student's Academic Adviser supporting the application
5. Applicant must be nominated by the partner university/institution through the International Office

**The minimum English language proficiency requirements vary by faculty.*

Applicant contact home university for nomination



Applicant completes UNIMAS Inbound application form and prepared all the required documents



Applicant submits completed application forms with required documents to university mobility coordinator for nomination



University mobility coordinator submits candidate's application to UNIMAS Global office



Partner university receives response from UNIMAS Global on application status



Partner university receives offer letter for successful applicants and information on visa application from UNIMAS Global



Students starts to apply for a visa



Once visa has been approved, students provide flight itinerary to UNIMAS Global Office for pick-up service
